For MP3 Audiobooks

We recommend that you search for and check out ebook titles on a computer.
Your device is only needed after you borrow and download an item.

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

INITIAL SET-UP:

- To access OverDrive, go to www.flwlib.org and click on the “**OverDrive**” link on the left side of the webpage. Continue to follow the OverDrive links until you reach “**Wisconsin’s Digital Library.**”
- On the top right corner click “**Sign In.**”
- Select “**Eastern Shores Library System**” from the drop down menu. Enter your **library card number** (located on the back of your library card) and **PIN number** (usually the last 4 digits of your telephone number). Click **SIGN IN**. You are now signed into your OverDrive account.
- Scroll to the very bottom of Wisconsin Digital Library’s homepage and under “**Help**” select “**OverDrive App.**”
- On the new page that opens, select either Windows or Mac from the **Devices** menu across the top of the page. Select the OverDrive app that is listed under your device type (Windows or Mac) and specific operating system (Windows 7, 8, or 10, etc.)
- After you have downloaded the software, open the OverDrive app and log-in using your library card, using the same credentials as previously. Then return to **Wisconsin’s Digital Library** on your desktop web browser.
- Prior to browsing, click on **My account** and select **Settings** from the drop-down menu. Here you can change your lending periods for items and other content preferences

HOW TO CHECK-OUT:

- To find items, you can search by title or author and browse by subject or collection. These guides are provided on the top menu. To return to the home page, you can click on the Wisconsin’s Digital Library logo at anytime.
- After selecting a book, you can click **borrow** to get the book. If there is a waitlist, it will prompt you to **place a hold** on the title.
- After borrowing a book, return to the **My account** menu and select **Loans**. Any current loans will appear here. If you are on a hold for any items, you can find them listed on the **holds** page.
- To start listening to loaned items, on the Loans page next to the book cover select “**Add to App.**” Your item will begin to download.
- Once the download is complete, connect your MP3 player to the computer via USB cord. In the OverDrive desktop app, highlight the book cover and in the right corner select “**Transfer.**” A transfer wizard will open to walk you through the transfer process to your MP3 Player.

HELPFUL TIP

Trouble logging in to your library account? Check with circulation staff to make sure your PIN is correct, your registration hasn’t expired, and any outstanding fines have been paid.
